# TRAIL ACCESS

Registration provides trail access for athletes and coaches for the official practice day, Thursday February 1<sup>st</sup> 2024 and the three competition days.

Anyone else wanting to use the trails must pay the required access fees at the club house.

# WAXING FACILITY

Teams with a waxing trailer are invited to park them in a designated parking lot, on the right hand side of the main parking. Vehicules will be parked away from the designated parking lot. There will be no access to power in the waxing trailer parking. A large waxing tent with heat and access to electricity will be set up near the clubhouse. Teams must reserve a space with the race secretariat at <u>secretariat@skidefondorford.qc.ca</u>. Teams may also choose to install their own tent on site.

There will be no access to electricity in the start area. For sprint days, restrictions on waxing between heats may apply as determined by the jury.

Their will be onsite surveillance between 18h00 and 6h00. However teams remain responsible for their belongings left on site.

#### TEST AND WARMUP LOOPS

There will be a test loop with classical tracks set in the middle near the waxing compound. Athletes can warm up or cool down there or on another loop set to the north-east of the start-finish area towards Bishop's University. Access to that loop will be indicated on site.

# PROGRAM

Competitions will be held over 3 days :

- Friday February 2<sup>nd</sup> 2024: Free technique Sprints for U20 and open categories. As specified in section 6.3 of NC Technical package, positions 1 to 30 of the quakifier will be placed in the open eliminatory bracket. The best U20 after the 30<sup>th</sup> position will be placed in another eliminatory bracket. Free technique interval start distances for all other categories.
- Saturday February 3<sup>rd</sup> 2024: Classical technique interval start distances for U20 and open categories. Classical technique sprints for U18 et U16 categories. Classical technique prologue for the U14 categorie and sprints for paranordique athletes standing and seated.
- Sunday February 4<sup>th</sup> 2024: Free technique mass start for all categories.

#### Seeding

Athletes confirmation list will be available on <u>Zone4</u> event page. Coaches and athletes must verify its content and notify the registrar of any mistake by emailing <u>secretariat@skidefondorford.qc.ca</u> before Thursday February 1<sup>st</sup> 12h00.

The seed lists for all events will be available for correction at 12h00 the day before the race. Corrections will be accepted until 15h00 on the same day, either in person at the race office or by email at <a href="mailto:secretariat@skidefondorford.qc.ca">secretariat@skidefondorford.qc.ca</a>.

Seeding will be done according to section 6 of the Nordiq Canada, Canada Cups Technical Package 2023-24.

The starting positions of the Para-Nordic racers will be determined by double blind draw. Seeding distance and sprint lists will be available online at 12h00 on Thursday February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, for review. Please contact the race secretary at <u>secretariat@skidefondorford.qc.ca</u> before 15h00 on February 1<sup>st</sup> 2024 should any corrections be required.

When deciding to race up, athletes and coaches should consider <u>NC Competition Pathway</u>. Athletes wishing to race up must confer with their coaches and parents to choose the most appropriate category to compete in. For registration purposes, athletes who decide to race up should choose the first year of competition in the older category. Racing up will not be allowed if the athlete could not otherwise compete in his natural category.

# LICENCES

- A. All athletes must hold a valid Nordiq Canada race license, either race, developpment, associate or tier 2 event for every competition day.
- B. All athletes living in the province of Québec must hold a valid SFQ, either annual or dayly for every competition day. Only Masters and U14 athletes can compete with dayly licenses.
- C. A FIS licence is required for athletes of the open categories in order to access FIS points, prize money and prizes.
- D. An annual SFQ licence is required to obtain a Coupe Québec ranking.
- E. CCUNC athletes must respect the previous obligation and meet their province requirements in order to qualify for CCUNC rankings. In Québec, the annexe A of the Règlements de la Coupe Québec applies.

#### USE OF FLUORINATED PRODUCTS

As per ICR–CCR 222.8, the use of fluorinated wax or tuning products containing fluorine including kick wax is not allowed for all categories.

#### DOPING CONTROL

Athletes and coaches must be aware that doping control tests may be conducted by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) on a random basis in accordance with the Canadian Anti-Doping Program. For more information, please see section 11.7 of the Nordiq Canada, Canada Cups Technical Package 2023-24.

#### PRIZES AND MEDALS

Ceremonies will be based on unofficial results 45 minutes after completion of every race. An athlete must be present at the ceremony in order to receive his/her prizes.

- There will be prize money and prizes but no medals for open, senior, CCUNC and para-nordique categories.
- The top 6 athletes of the open categories will receive prizes.
- The top 6 athletes of the U20 categories will receive prizes. For the sprint event, the results of U20 athletes competing in the open category will precede the results of the U20 category.
- The top U23 performance will be recognized for each event.
- The OC wishes to award prizes to the top 6 athletes of the CCUNC category in order to recogniz the importance of athletic performances in a scholar environnement. For the sprint event, qualification rankings will be used.
- For U14, U16 and U18 categories, the first three athletes will receive prizes and medals. Athletes ranked 4th and 5th will be invited to join the podium but will not get prizes.

#### REGISTRATION

Registration and paiements must be done online through <u>Zone4</u> starting Tuesday January 2<sup>nd</sup> 2024 at 12h00. Regular registartions close on Friday January 26th 2024 23 h 59 HNE. After that date, an extra 100\$ CAD fee will be charged per race. The fees will be payable at the race secretariat and all registrations will have to be authorized by the jury. Please adress your request to <u>secretariat@skidefondorford.qc.ca</u>.

Athletes and coaches must verify the confimation list online before Thursday February 1st 2024 12h00 and the seed list before 15h00 on the same day. For any problems, please coontact the race secretary adn registrar at <u>secretariat@skidefondorford.qc.ca</u>. All FIS, NC and SFQ licenses will be validated and required athletes will have until Wednesday January 31<sup>st</sup> 2024, 23h59 to remedy all issues oulined by the race secretariat.

Coaches and team members must register on <u>Zone4</u> to allow the OC to create an email list and what'sapp group to be used for all ciommunication purposes during the event. The <u>Zone4</u> event page and event web site, <u>2024 Easterns</u>, will also be used for all communication purposes.

The OC has absolutely no intention to refund any subscription fees. Sickness, injuries, infection and other badlucks are unfortunately part of our sport. Participants wishing to ask a refund can however do so by detailing their request to <u>secretariat@skidefondorford.qc.ca</u>. The OC will answer all requests after the event to it's own discretion.

Student athletes from other Canadian provinces or American institutions must meet the requirements of their teaching authority and provide a written confirmation of their status in order to access the CCUNC prizes.

Should an event be cancelled for other reasons than cold or adverse weather conditions, some costs could be refunded by the OC according to the NC guidelines and taking into account the OC obligations.

There will be no refund for unduly purchased licenses or SFQ or XCSO fees.

Bibs will be given per club as showing in the registration form. Distribution will take place on the first floor of the clubhouse on the morning of every race. A 75\$ fee will be charged for any missing bib.

Transponders will be distributed to athletes in the start area. A 125\$ fee will be charged for any missing transponder.

Competitions will take place at the Old - Vieux Lennox Golf & Ski located at 19 rue Du Golf, Sherbrooke, QC J1M 2E6.

#### PARKING

The Golf club parking lot offers a very limted number of parking spots. There is a largely sufficent number of parking spots on the adjacent Bishop's University campus. The campus is about 600 Meters away from the race site. Street parking in the Lennoxvill burrough of the city of Sherbrooke is forbidden, namely on du golf, Winder and Massawipi streets. Municipal police is never far on special event days, please act accordingly.

#### SURVEILLANCE

There will be an onsite presence from 18h00 to 6h00. However, teams are responsible of their and their athletes' belongings staying onsite.




